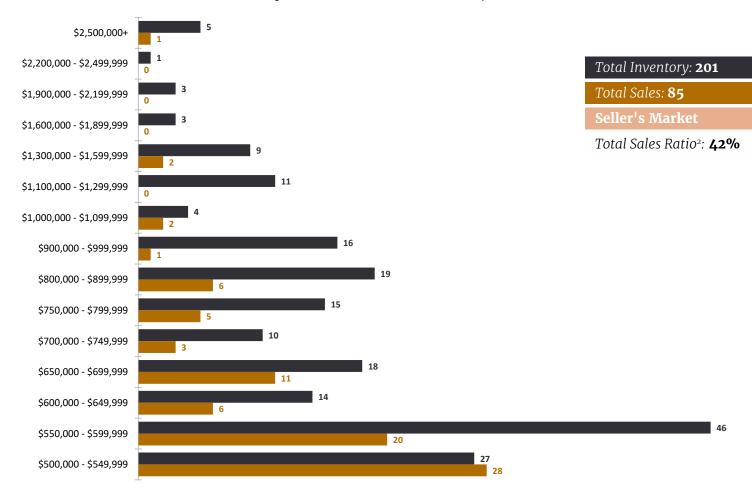

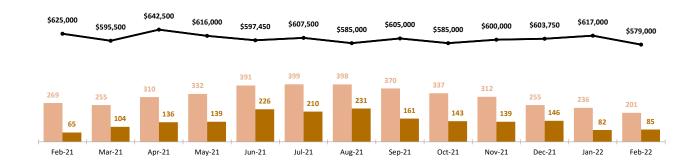

CENTRAL CONNECTICUT MARKET SUMMARY | FEBRUARY 2022

- The Central Connecticut single-family luxury market is a **Seller's Market** with a **42%** Sales Ratio.
- Homes sold for a median of **100.00% of list price** in February 2022.
- The most active price band is **\$500,000-\$549,999**, where the sales ratio is **104%**.
- The median luxury sales price for single-family homes is \$579,000.
- The median days on market for February 2022 was 47 days, down from 67 in February 2021.
