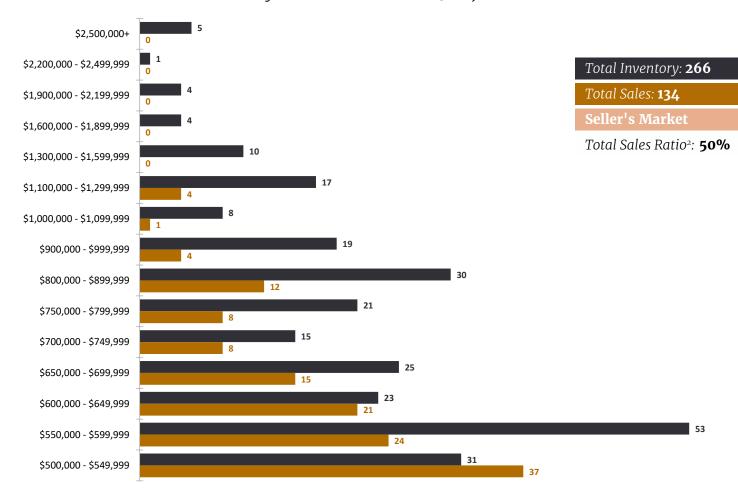

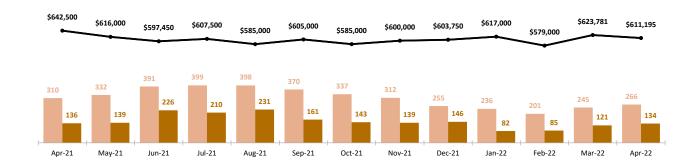

CENTRAL CONNECTICUT MARKET SUMMARY | APRIL 2022

- The Central Connecticut single-family luxury market is a **Seller's Market** with a **50%** Sales Ratio.
- Homes sold for a median of **104.76% of list price** in April 2022.
- The most active price band is **\$500,000-\$549,999**, where the sales ratio is **119%**.
- The median luxury sales price for single-family homes is **\$611,195**.
- The median days on market for April 2022 was 5 days, down from 42 in April 2021.
