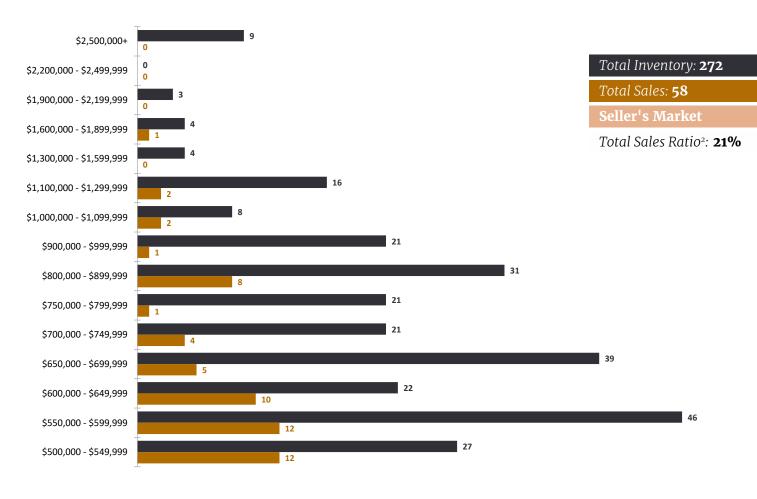

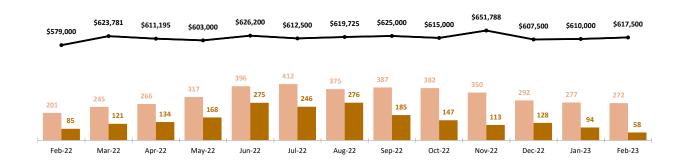

CENTRAL CONNECTICUT MARKET SUMMARY | FEBRUARY 2023

- The Central Connecticut single-family luxury market is a **Seller's Market** with a **21% Sales Ratio**.
- Homes sold for a median of **100.00% of list price** in February 2023.
- The most active price band is \$600,000-\$649,999, where the sales ratio is 45%.
- The median luxury sales price for single-family homes is \$617,500.
- The median days on market for February 2023 was 20 days, down from 47 in February 2022.
